Leading Causes of Death in Vietnam

• 60% of poor households in rural Northern Vietnam were in debt, and a third of them cited payment for health care as the main reason for their debt (Whitehead, Dahlgren, & Evans, 2001) • 31% of poor families choose to self-treat, instead of seeking medical care (Thuanet al, 2008)

EMS Services in Rural America: Challenges and Opportunities

The CDC finds that from 1999 to 2015, the opioid death rates in rural areas of the US have quadrupled among those 18-25 years old and tripled for females¹³ In fact, the overall rate of drug overdose in rural areas has surpassed that of metropolitan areas over roughly the last two decades
