A rolefor environmental auditing in tourism Environmental auditing is a means to an end, by which environmental considerations are integrated into tourism business decisions Since there are no legal requirements requiring firms to prepare envi-ronmental audits it is, therefore, a means of self-regu-lation Environmental auditing is defined as 'a
