Modify Employee Health Insurance Benefits if Allowed Hawaii’s Prepaid Health Care Act Ensures Health Coverage for Some Workers Hawaii’s Prepaid Health Care Act of 1974 is the only act of its kind in US history Since Jan 1, 1975, this law has required nearly all employers to provide health insurance to their employees

Health Care Proxy Appointing Your Health Care Agent in New York State The New York Health Care Proxy Law allows you to appoint someone you trust — for example, a family member or close friend - to make health care decisions for you if you lose the ability to make decisions yourself By appointing a health care agent, you can make sure

The Health Care Proxy Law

A health care agent is appointed by a written document called a health care proxy The Proxy Law calls the person who creates a proxy the “principal” Any competent adult can appoint an agent Adults are presumed competent to create a health care proxy unless they have been found otherwise by a court
