broken The smaller bones in the wrist, called the carpal bones, can also break or ligaments can tear The scaphoid is the most common carpal bone to be fractured Most wrist fracture can be treated with casting either with or without 'straightening' the bone out first Straighten the bone is called a 'reduction'

INSTRUCTION SHEET: RIB/CHEST BRUISE

Pain with a broken rib often takes a month or two to go away A bruise and a cracked rib are both treated in the same manner, with rest and medicine by mouth to control the pain if necessary MEASURES YOU SHOULD TAKE TO HELP TREAT YOUR BRUISED RIBS: 1 Rest the injured area, giving your body time to heal Avoid activities such as heavy lifting,

- Fractures that heal in positions outside the aforementioned guidelines may remodel or go on to good clinical result - BUT May Not!!! - Children <10 years old have more potential to remodel - Remodeling more reliable in plane of joint motion (ie proximal tibia sagittal plane deformity more acceptable b/c of

Surgery may be needed for fractures that fail to heal, broken bones that come through the skin, or broken bones that are a threat to nearby nerves, blood vessels, soft tissues, or joints The surgery involves aligning the bone in the proper position and securing it in place with surgical hardware, such as screws and plates The
