Breastfeeding It is difficult to assign a single definition to the term "breastfeeding," because there are multiple behaviors that constitute breastfeeding
 The term may be used in reference to full breastfeeding, partial breastfeeding, token breastfeeding, or exclusive expression of milk using a breast pump (Labbok & Krasovec, 1990)
