THE DEATH PENALTY WORLDWIDE Over half the world's countries have abolished capital punishment, either by statute or de facto 89 countries have abolished capital punishment for all felonies 10 countries have abolished the death penalty for all felonies except crimes of an exceptional nature, such as those committed in wartime
