### **Restitution: A Payback for Victims**

By law, each probation division is responsible for collecting restitution from offenders who are placed on Pre-Trial Intervention or who are sentenced to probation or to county jail If defendants become delinquent in paying their court ordered restitution, the Comprehensive Enforcement Program (CEP) can summon them to court
