MODES OF RESTORATIVE JUSTICE Conferencing Youth Justice Conferencing is a formalised legal process which provides victims an opportunity to face the offender who has committed a crime against them This process aims to give the victim a voice to express the harm caused against them, and for the offender to repair the harm they have
